4. The bid must be accompanied by a **three** (**3**) **years'** bid securing declaration and shall be valid for a period of 120 days after bid opening.

5. **Participation** is restricted to **Citizen** and **Local** Bidders only as per Zambia Public Procurement Regulations of 2022 (PPR) guidelines. In an event that the local Bidder is awarded the contract, the local Bidder shall partner with the citizen supplier. A local bidder who participates in the procurement process shall include in the bid—

(a) the name of the citizen bidder that the local bidder shall partner with if awarded the contract;

(b) the documentation on the partnership arrangements between the local bidder and citizen supplier or bidder; and

(c) any other documentation stated in the solicitation document.

- 6. Bidding will be conducted using **Open National Bidding (ONB)** procedures specified under Zambia Public Procurement Regulations of 2022 (PPR)
